Lady Bulldogs vs Shorter University Lady Hawks

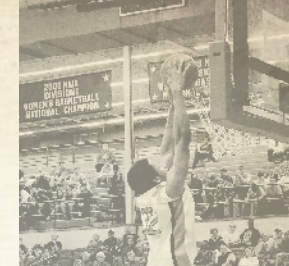

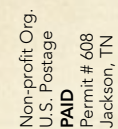
