You must initiate the transfer process (i.e. Submit this form to Union University's International Student Office) within the following timelines: a. If you have completed your degree requirements, no later than 60 days after the end of the semester in which you graduated. b. If you are currently in your period of post-completion Optional Practical Training (OPT), no later than 60 days after the OPT end date (as noted on your Employment Authorization Document – EAD). c. If you are a continuing student withdrawing from Union University, no later than 30 days from the start of the semester that you will NOT be enrolled at Union University. 3. Once you have determined the school that you will be attending, you must choose the date when your SEVIS record should be released to your transfer institution. Please note our office will NOT have access to your SEVIS record after the release date. If you wish to cancel the transfer and/or change the transfer school, you must do so before the noted release date or you 	
4.	will have to arrange it with the school to which your record was transferred. The release date can be no later than five (5) months after completion of studies at Union University. If you need help determining the best release date, please talk to the International Student Advisor at Union University.	
5.	According to USCIS regulations, you must begin classes at the new school no later than five months from the program completion date at Union University. Please speak to the International Student Advisor at the new school to find out what specific enrollment requirements the school has.	
6.	6. To complete the transfer process, you must report to the International Student Advisor at the new school within 10 days of the new program start date listed on your SEVIS I-20 from. Otherwise, your SEVIS record will be terminated and you may be our of status.
