Science classes must be taken in a face-to-face format, not online. Students must prove they have had one year of American History at the High School level or 6 h at the college level to graduate from UTHSC.

GPA of Average Entering Student 3.3 at UT Memphis. 2.5 is the minimum required for application and GPAs above a 3.0 are considered competitive. (D grades are NOT acceptable and must be retaken. If a required course is retaken, both grades are used by UTHSC in calculating the GPA.)
